De gustibus non est disputandum. Loosely translated: you can't argue about colours or tastes. Yet that is exactly what our 'brick committee' did in recent months: our experts put their heads together to determine the new brick collection.

The result? A range with eleven new colours that dance to the rhythm of the times. A building is a subtle interplay of shapes and colours. The choice of facing brick is therefore quite decisive: its distinctive colour gives a building personality.

From Crema and Luce to Alma. From Stella to Kratos and Dione. Browse through the brochure and be inspired.

COLOURS WITH CHARACTER

CREMA

Crema: the 'crème de la crème'

A light grey to white top layer adds cachet to the yellowish basic colour. The primary colour stands out subtly through the light cement coating. The colour shade changes in humid conditions. As a result, the façade continues to surprise.





LUCE light up your façade

The coloured sintering - together with different types of sand - gives the yellowish basic colour accents that vary from white, through yellow and light grey to darker shades. The white deposits play a key role here.







ALMA a brick with soul

Just like Crema and Luce, Alma also starts from a yellow basic colour. It is given extra character by colour shades ranging from yellow to light pink to black.

STELLA shines like a star

The yellow undertone is much more prominent in this brick. Compared to the previous three, you get - thanks to the coloured sintering - a main tone that fluctuates around ochre with greyish accents.

KRATOS a brick that radiates strength

The ageing process acentuates the brick's red basic colour temperament. The shades range from reddish-brown to beige, with brown and white nuances and white deposits that provide depth.





VIALE the brick with warm nuances

The red basic colour is expressed more evenly in this brick: the bricks vary from red-brown to beige. But the nuances in the individual stone are more subtle. Although you get brown and white nuances here too.



DIONE heavenly red

Here too, you start from a red basic colour. But compared to Kratos, you get more extreme colour variations between reddish-brown and beige, alternating with brown and white nuances, after the ageing process.



FALO joy in a brick

The red basic colour stands out here. Thanks to the coloured sintering, the shades vary from orange-red to dark red. This gives you a fiery result with light nuances.

TESORO a noble brick

The brick colour starts from a yellowish or dark grey base. It subtly shines through the light cement coating. The colour shade changes in humid conditions.







TORBA **natural beauty**

The coloured sintering gives a surprising colour shade to the grey-brown basic colour. The subtle variations between the bricks range from grey to dark grey. This gives a subtle and balanced end result.

DRAGO a fire-breathing brick

Different types of sand create a pronounced range of hues, through coloured sintering, ranging from light brown to purple-brown. The blue colour deposits lend dynamism to the colours in the façade.
